- d. undertake, ex MD 630/2024, from a min. of six (6) to a max. of twelve (12) months of research and study periods abroad as indicated in the thematically binding research projects (see Technical Sheet B and C);
- e. ensure compliance with obligations regarding communication and information provided for by art. 34 of Regulation (EU) 2021/241, indicating in the project documentation that the Program is funded under the PNRR, with explicit reference to funding from the European Union and the NextGenerationEU initiative (for ex. using the phrase "funded from the European Union - NextGenerationEU"), reporting the emblem of the European Union in the project documentation and providing adequate dissemination and promotion of the Program, including online, both web and social, in line with the provisions of the NRPP Communication Strategy ;
- f. ensure that the implementation of project activities is consistent with the specific principles and obligations of the NRRP with regard to the principle of "Do no significant harm" (DNSH) under Article 17 of Reg. (EU) 2020/852 and, where applicable, with the principles of digital tagging, gender equality (Gender Equality) in relation to Articles 2, 3(3) TEU, 8, 10, 19, and 157 TFEU, and 21 and 23 of the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union, protection and empowerment of young people, and bridging territorial gaps;
- g. ensure compliance with the cross-cutting principles provided for the NRRP in national and EU legislation, with particular regard to the protection and enhancement of young people and overcoming territorial gaps.
