PhD Program in POLITICS Cycle XLII - A.Y. 2026/2027

Administrative headquarters: Department of Political Science, Luiss University **Statutory Duration of the Program:** 3 years

a) Educational Goals and Research Themes:

The Department of Political Science at Luiss University invites applications for 7 fully funded PhD scholarships to commence PhD studies in the academic year 2025/2026. The PhD program is entirely in English and has a duration of three years. Supervision will be mainly provided by Professors, members of the Academic Board. The program also facilitates exchanges with partner universities abroad and provides additional financial support to enable such study periods and field work.

The Department of Political Science boasts established excellence across several research clusters — European Integration and Public Policies; Elections and Political Systems; Global and International Studies; Communication, Sustainability and Social Innovation — as well as within its dedicated research centers (Research Center for European Analysis and Policy; Research Center for International and Strategic Studies; Research Center on Democracy).

The Department therefore welcomes the submission of research projects focusing on these topics, approached from a political science, sociological, historical, philosophical, or legal perspective.

b) Places on offer:

- Number of places with ordinary scholarship: n. 5
- Number of places with scholarship with increased funding, reserved for international candidates who satisfy all of the requisites listed immediately below: n.1
 - not in possession of Italian Citizenship;
 - not having had residency or domicile in Italy, or having carried out their main activity in Italy, for more than 6 months, even non-consecutively, in the three years preceding this Call for Applications;



qualification for access to a Doctoral Program obtained in a foreign university.

Should a suitable candidate not be found, this place will be added, without additional funding, to the 5 ordinary University scholarship places and will be attributed in accordance with the same merit system as for those places.

Total places on offer on the PhD Program: n. 6

c) Selection Process:

The selection process for admission to the doctoral program consists of two phases:

1. First Phase: Evaluation of the Research Proposal, CV and the qualifications contained therein.

In this phase the Research Proposal, CV and qualifications contained therein will be examined.

- (a) The **Research Proposal (to be mandatory submitted)** will be evaluated taking into account its academic and societal relevance, its quality, rigor and promise in terms of delivering original research findings and its relation to the expertise available in the various research clusters of the Political Science Department. It must be written in English and has to include a clear statement of the research question or issues to be addressed, the state of the art on the topic complete with references to the literature, the analytical framework and methodology proposed, an indication of the sources for data collection and a brief bibliography.
- (b) **CV and qualifications (to be mandatory submitted)** will be evaluated taking into account the prior qualifications and any other relevant elements indicated in a candidate's **curriculum vitae**.

2. Second Phase: Interview with the Selection Committee

The **interview** will focus on the research proposal submitted and will concern topics and subjects pertinent thereto (even if not directly covered by the Research Proposal itself but which relate to the areas under study in the Doctoral Program).

It is designed to assess not only the applicant's depth of knowledge regarding the proposal submitted but also the candidate's ability to engage in critical thinking and scientific enquiry, and to assess the candidate's motivations and objectives in entering the PhD program.

Interviews will be conducted in English, this being the working language of the PhD Program. The interview be held in presence or remotely.

The minimum score for eligibility (60 points) is to be understood as the sum of the points assigned from the three phases, with the candidate having attained at least the minimum score in both of the selection phases.

e) Method of Submission of Candidature:

To submit an application to participate in the competition candidates must:

 - and log into the designated online platform;
- select the "Politics XLII" Doctoral Program within the platform;
- fill out the competition application in full, attaching the required documents, specifically:



MANDATORY DOCUMENTATION:

- "PhD Politics Application Form B" (which can be found at the end of this document) completed, dated and signed
- Research proposal, consistent with the educational goals and the themes of the Doctoral Program;
- Curriculum vitae, indicating all qualifications held (for example, master's degree, advanced courses, other PhDs, etc.), research undertaken, any publications, study and work periods either abroad or of international relevance, and certified knowledge of English and of any additional foreign languages other than English;
- National ID card/passport;
- Two reference letters;

The letters should not be uploaded onto the platform (transmitted exclusively by Teaching/Academic Staff): the candidate must insert within the platform the names and email addresses of their 2 referents, who will receive a link at the indicated email addresses through which they can compile and send a reference letter to the PhD & Education Funding Office.

The deadline for submitting reference letters is set for 30 January 2026.

f) Deadlines:

- Deadline for submission of applications: 16:00 (CET), UTC+1 on 23 January 2026.
- Deadline for the award of any prerequisite qualification for the doctoral program: 15 September 2026.
- Deadline for publication of the ranking for admission purposes: within 31 July 2026, unless extended with a specific communication on Luiss website.

The ranking order and list of those admitted will be published on the Doctoral Program website (link: https://phd.luiss.it/politics/admission-and-ranking-list/) and communicated by e-mail to the successful candidates in accordance with article 5 of the call for applications.



- Deadline for sending notice of the ranking for admission purposes to successful candidates: within 7 days, start counting the day after publication of the ranking order and list of those admitted on the University's website (http://www.luiss.it) and the associated concurrent notice of admission.
- Program start: October 2026.
